 - c. You won't care about how much money you have (vs. 13a, 9-10).
 - d. You will have taken major hits for talking about Jesus (vs. 14-16).
 - e. You will have let go of seeking revenge or getting even (vs. 14-16).
 - f. You will have seen miraculous transformations in people (vs. 19-12).
 - g. You will have precious few real friends (v. 11a).
 - h. You will want to be with God more than anything (vs. 9-13, 8, 18).
 - i. You will testify to the Lord's presence with you at all times (vs. 16-17, 22).
