

Table Talk Questions for Sunday, September 20, 2020

2 Timothy 4:1-5

- 1. Have you ever heard someone share their last words with you? What did they say?**
- 2. These were Paul's last words to Timothy. Why do you think Paul was so serious (solemn)?**
- 3. Read verses 3-4. Why do you think we so often tend towards ease? How have you noticed this in your own life, as it relates to following Jesus?**
- 4. What does the second half of verse 2 say about our need for others in our lives? What kind of posture should we have when we are with one another? Why is this so important?**
- 5. Can you think of a time when someone spoke truth to you, with grace and love? What impact did it have?**
- 6. Is there anyone in your life now who you trust to do this with/for you? If so, who? If not, why not?**
- 7. Based off of verse 1 and the first part of verse 2, Pastor Matt said we can never – ever over-emphasize Jesus and the Gospel. Do you think many Christians/churches are “guilty” of talking about Jesus too much? Why or why not?**
- 8. Paul said in verse 5 to “do the work of an evangelist.” This means to have the character of one who is always sharing good news. Are you known as someone who is always bringing good news into the world? Is our church? Why might now be a more critical time than ever to be known as those who deliver good news to others?**
