

Conversation Starters and Prayer Prompts

WHO GOD IS

Deuteronomy 6:4-9 - 4

"Listen, Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is One. 5 Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. 6 These words that I am giving you today are to be in your heart. 7 Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Bind them as a sign on your hand and let them be a symbol on your forehead. 9 Write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- What is your favorite thing about God and why?
- What is your favorite way to connect to God (Prayer, Service, Worship, etc.)? Why?
- How has God really moved in your life over the past year?
- How do you like to keep "these words that I am giving you today" "in your heart"?
- What does it mean to you to "love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength"? What do you think it means in terms of how we are to love each other?
- How can we share what God has done in our lives with others? ("Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road...") Is there anything you would like to do to be more intentional about sharing stories of God's faithfulness with the next generation?

PRAYER PROMPTS

- Praise God for who He is in your life and His faithfulness to you. Ask Him to help you keep Him at the center of your life, marriage and family.
- Pray for God to help you see opportunities to share God's faithfulness in your life with your children / grandchildren / extended family and others ("Repeat them to your children. Talk about them when you sit in your house and when you walk along the road...")
