

Conversation Starters and Prayer Prompts

WHERE WE'RE GOING

Deuteronomy 1:6-8

6 "The Lord our God spoke to us at Horeb: 'You have stayed at this mountain long enough. 7 Resume your journey and go to the hill country of the Amorites and their neighbors in the Arabah, the hill country, the Judean foothills, the Negev and the sea coast—to the land of the Canaanites and to Lebanon as far as the Euphrates River. 8 See, I have set the land before you. Enter and take possession of the land the Lord swore to give to your fathers Abraham, Isaac, and lacob and their future descendants.'

CONVERSATION STARTERS

- Of the nine Fruits of the Spirit (joy, love, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, self-control) which one do you believe God has uniquely equipped you with? What do you believe God is calling you to do with this gift? ("You have stayed at this mountain long enough. Resume your journey and go...")
- How can you "shine like stars in the sky as you hold firmly to the word of life" (Philippians 2:15,16)? How can your light shine in your work, your family, your community?
- Share a story about a time when you had a conversation where you told someone about God and His work in your life. How you encourage each other to look for these opportunities in our daily life?

PRAYER PROMPTS

• Thank God for how He continues to equip you to follow Him in the midst of a fallen world. Ask Him to help you continue to grow in His Word and share your faith with others. Ask Him to help you stand out as a light to others.
