Title: God Deserves Our Worship

Passage: Leviticus 1-4

Christ Connection:

God deserves our worship. He created us to be in a relationship with Him, and He has provided salvation from sin through His Son Jesus. We can worship God by loving and obeying Him as we live to give Him glory.

Questions to Discuss:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- What are some ways that you can worship God with your words and actions this week?
- What are some things in your life that prevent you from worshiping God?

Family Connection:

Go out and play some type of game together: go bowling, play racquetball, find a basketball court and play "horse," or even play a board game - whatever your family loves to do. When you finish, compile a list in writing of all the rules associated with this game. Leave nothing out but go overboard in being nit-picky and specific. When you've finished, ask who has never, ever broken one of the rules in this game. Explain that the Bible also contains rules. Ask if anyone has never, ever broken any of the rules God gave us. Point out that the law helps us understand the standard, and therefore when we break it, we understand we need a Savior because we can't possibly keep the whole law.

Parent Action:

Is there anything in your life that God has told you clearly to do but you have refused to do it? Have you surrendered your time, talents, treasures, and testimony to the Lordship of Jesus?
