Title: God Encouraged Joshua

Passage: Joshua 1

Christ Connection:

God encouraged Joshua and promised to be with him as he led the Israelites into the promised land, where they would be victorious and find rest. We have victory over sin and rest for our souls in Jesus, who is with us always and leads us into the promised land of God's kingdom.

Questions to Discuss:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- How can knowing God is with us help us be brave?

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- Who can we encourage by telling them that God is with them?

Family Connection:

Choose an art medium (or offer several choices for family members to choose from) and give family members a few minutes to create their own work of art that illustrates what it looks like to them to be strong and courageous. Allow each family member to explain their work of art, then ask, if it hasn't already been explained, what area of life in which they feel strong and courageous. Then ask, in what area of life do you feel like you need God to help you be strong and courageous, because you feel weak and scared? Take a few minutes to pray specifically for each family member and what they've shared.

Parent Action:

In your obedience to Jesus, what is one area you are struggling with faith and need to be "strong and courageous?"

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
