**Title:** Jesus' Triumphal Entry

**Passage:** Matthew 21; Mark 11; Luke 19; John 12

**Christ Connection:**

The people were happy to see Jesus. They knew He was their King. Jesus came riding on a donkey, just as the prophet Zechariah said He would (Zechariah 9:9). One day, Jesus will come back, riding on a white horse as King over everything.

### **Family Connection:**

Choose an art medium (or offer several choices for family members to choose from) and give family members a few minutes to create their own work of art that illustrates what it looks like to them to have joy. Allow each family member to explain their work of art, then ask, if it hasn’t already been explained, what area of life in which they feel great joy. Then ask, in what area of life do you feel like you need God to help you be joyful? Take a few minutes to pray specifically for each family member and what they’ve shared.

### **Parent Action:**

Take time each day this week to share the Gospel with your child. Help them understand the good news of Jesus.

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
