Title: Jesus' Crucifixion & Resurrection

Passage: Matthew 26-28; John 20

Christ Connection:

Jesus died on the cross to pay for sin and rose again to defeat death. We deserve to die because of our sin, but Jesus died in our place. Because Jesus is alive, we do not need to fear anything. Those who trust in Jesus have forgiveness and eternal life, and we can joyfully obey Him. Jesus' death and resurrection is the center of the gospel. Jesus died to pay for our sins. Jesus is alive! God gives hope and true joy to everyone who trusts in Jesus.

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Questions to Discuss:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- How does Jesus' resurrection give us joy?
- Who can you share the good news of the gospel with this week?

Family Connection:

Choose an art medium (or offer several choices for family members to choose from) and give family members a few minutes to create their own work of art that illustrates what it looks like to them to have joy. Allow each family member to explain their work of art, then ask, if it hasn't already been explained, what area of life in which they feel great joy. Then ask, in what area of life do you feel like you need God to help you be joyful? Take a few minutes to pray specifically for each family member and what they've shared.

Parent Action:

Take time each day this week to share the Gospel with your child. Help them understand the good news of Jesus.

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
