## OUR KEY INITIATIVES

### 1. DxD Strategy | Gospel Conversations

Train and Equip our people for gospel conversations through a unified resource and resulting in 50% of our church members being equipped.

### 2. DxD Strategy | Groups

Increase Group engagement to 80% of worship attendance by equipping new leaders and starting new groups.

### 3. DxD Strategy | Go

- Engage 50% of our congregation in local mission and community needs.
- Establish 5 new national partners
- Leverage the 2025 Global Worker Gathering to increase awareness of global opportunities

### 4. DxD Strategy | Gather

Explore opportunities to increase engagement in weekly gatherings and create a culture of gospel response.

### 5. DxD Strategy | Giving

Increase our giving base 10% this year by implementing stewardship initiatives at every age level and stage of life.

### 6. Multiplication | Expand our multiplication movement of healthy churches by:

- Establishing a bi-vocational residency track
- Further defining our multiplication partnerships
- Resourcing multiplication movement by conferences, coaching, consulting and creating resources.
